

Medical Emergency

A medical emergency exists any time a school incident exceeds the need for basic first aid.

If a sick or injured person is in need of assistance:

1. In case of an emergency, check the scene for safety. Remove self and others out of harm's way.
2. When calling, stay calm and state the nature of the emergency. Do not hang up until told to do so.
3. Only administer as much first aid as you have been trained to do. Attempt to find a person trained in first aid if it is possible for you to leave the injured person.
4. First aid supplies will be made available, if the injured person will accept the supplies.
5. All safety precautions should be enforced and the injured person should not be moved until they have been checked by certified medical personnel, unless they are in a life threatening situation.
6. Faculty and staff should follow the universal precautions in handling body fluids as recommended by the Center of Disease Control, i.e., wear rubber gloves, double bag and notify the Director of Physical Plant (ext. 385).
7. A full report should be given to the Dean of Student Services (Wesson Campus), Vice President of the Natchez Campus or Vice President of the Simpson County Center by the person(s) administering aid to the victim.
