

As of July 1, 2016, the Accreditation Commission for Education in Nursing (ACEN) requires publication of student achievement data in the areas of graduates' success on the licensure exam, program/degree completion rates, and graduate job placement rates.

Associate Degree Nursing Student Achievement Data

Performance on the RN licensure exam:

State of MS Standard: Annual NCLEX®-RN pass rates for all test takers (1st and repeat) will be at 80% or above over a three-year period.

Results Data: May 2018 graduates/CY 2018 all write pass rate- 100%
May 2017 graduates/CY 2017 all write pass rate- 94.12%
May 2016 graduates/CY 2016 all write pass rate- 100%

CY=calendar year; 3 year mean: 98.5%

Performance on the RN licensure exam:

ACEN/National Standard: The program's most recent annual licensure examination pass rate will be at least 80% for all first-time-test-takers during the same 12-month period.

Results Data: May 2018 graduates/CY 2018 first write pass rate- 90%
May 2017 graduates/CY 2017 first write pass rate- 65%
May 2016 graduates/CY 2016 first write pass rate- 75%

Program/Degree Completion Rates:

State and National Standard: The expected level of achievement (50%) for program completion is determined by faculty and reflects program demographics.

Results Data: May 2018 graduates/degree completion rate- 46%
May 2017 graduates/degree completion rate- 47%
May 2016 graduates/degree completion rate- 53%

Job Placement Rates:

National Standard: The expected level of achievement (80%) for job placement* is determined by faculty and reflects program demographics.

Results Data: May 2018 graduates/CY 2018 job placement rate- 100%
May 2017 graduates/CY 2017 job placement rate- 95%
May 2016 graduates/CY 2016 job placement rate- 96%

*Job placement rate/employment in nursing 6 months after graduation
