Should a bomb threat be received, proceed as follows:

Attempt to obtain information from the caller (time set to detonate, location of the bomb, what it looks like, what kind of bomb it is; keep the caller on the line as long as possible; observe the age and sex of the caller, speech patterns, accent, and background noise).

- 1. Activate fire alarm to evacuate the building. Follow the building evacuation plan. Walk quickly but calmly to exits.
- 2. Make a prompt visual search to report unusual or foreign items. **DO NOT TOUCH OR MOVE SUSPICIOUS OBJECTS.**
- 3. Assist the physically challenged Elevators may be used.
- 4. Get at least 500 feet away from the building.
- 5. The President will make the decision for students and other personnel to re-enter the building.

Do not treat bomb threats as a joke!
